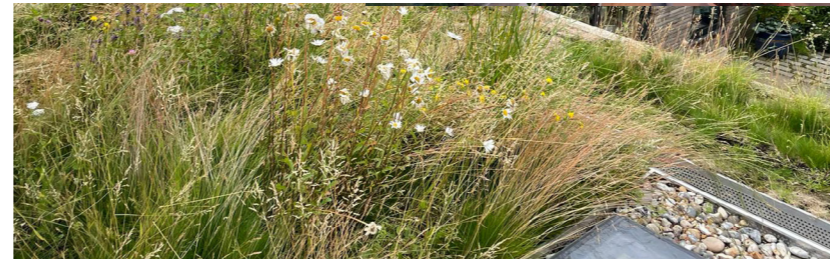
The proposal is landscape-led and promotes environmental sustainability. It respects the existing landscape and proposes further biodiversity enhancements:

- retention of existing mature hedgerow and new planting buffers to all boundaries
- green roofs and eco habitats
- reuse of existing topography and design around existing ground levels
- private or community-use greenhouses - for indoor home-growing, cultivating or preserving home-grown produce

It also takes further opportunity to consider future demands for energy-efficient delivery:

- sustainable building construction methods
- introduction of natural surface water features for sustainable drainage
- water butts and grey water recycling for reduction in water consumption
- renewable energy such as PV panels or air source heat pumps and electric charging points for energy efficiency or self-efficiency
